## SWINGCADDY

SwingCaddy is one the best value-for-money, fully remote-controlled buggies available.

The buggy is both lightweight and simple and, with very few unnecessary bells and whistles, is virtually bulletproof.

The 2021 model is the latest in a line of remote-control buggies stretching back 20 years; each one slightly better and more refined than its predecessor. The product now boasts a 10AH lithium battery that will easily power through 18 holes but weighs only 1,592 grams.

The entire buggy, including accessories and battery, weighs in at an easily manageable 15.2 kilograms.

It has a wide track and low centre of

gravity for extra stability and can be assembled and disassembled in minutes. It folds down to a size that will fit in most normal-sized car boots.
